Daily Activities:

- Snack Time (3:00 - 3:20 p.m.) - When the children arrive at aftercare, they will have time to socialize with friends and enjoy their afternoon snack.
- Outdoor/Indoor Recess (3:20 - 4:00 p.m.) - Depending on the weather, we will have outdoor or indoor recess.
- Homework Zone (4:00 - 5:00 p.m.) - After the students get some exercise, they will be able to work on their homework from that day. Teachers will provide support to students who need it. Students who do not have homework will choose a book or participate in an organized activity.
- Centers (5:00 - 6:00 p.m.) - Once homework is completed, students can choose a center to play in.

Center Choices

- Art - Students can cut, glue, color and draw pictures in this center. Holiday and seasonal patterns will be provided.
- Games - Students can enjoy card games, board games, and puzzles with their friends and teachers.
- Building Fun - Students can use Lego's, blocks or other materials to build cars, houses and cities.
