

St. Patrick's Catholic Pre-Kindergarten (4+) Program Offers:

- An early-childhood program for children who are 4 years of age by September 1, 2024, including a transitional program for Kindergartners.
- A new learning environment specifically designed and created for 4 year old students in our parish center.
- The focus will be on the whole child, as we help our youngest students to grow spiritually, academically, socially, and emotionally in a nurturing environment.
- A positive first time experience in school that will create life-long enthusiastic learners while growing in their faith.
- One classroom teacher and instructional assistant, create a 1:10 ratio in our classroom.
- · Weekly physical education/movement, music, Spanish, and art classes.
- Play-based learning while adhering to the Common Core standards set forth by the Maryland State Department of Education and Archdiocese of Washington.
- Inclusion in the elementary school outreach projects and special events celebrating successes, and our Catholic faith.
