3. Share the transcript release form with the administration at your child's current school.
4. Submit the pastor recommendation form to your current parish for completion and submit it to St. Patrick's School office.
5. St. Patrick's Catholic School review of documentation
6. Call the school office to schedule a visit day with your child's current class.
7. Notification of acceptances will begin in January 2026
